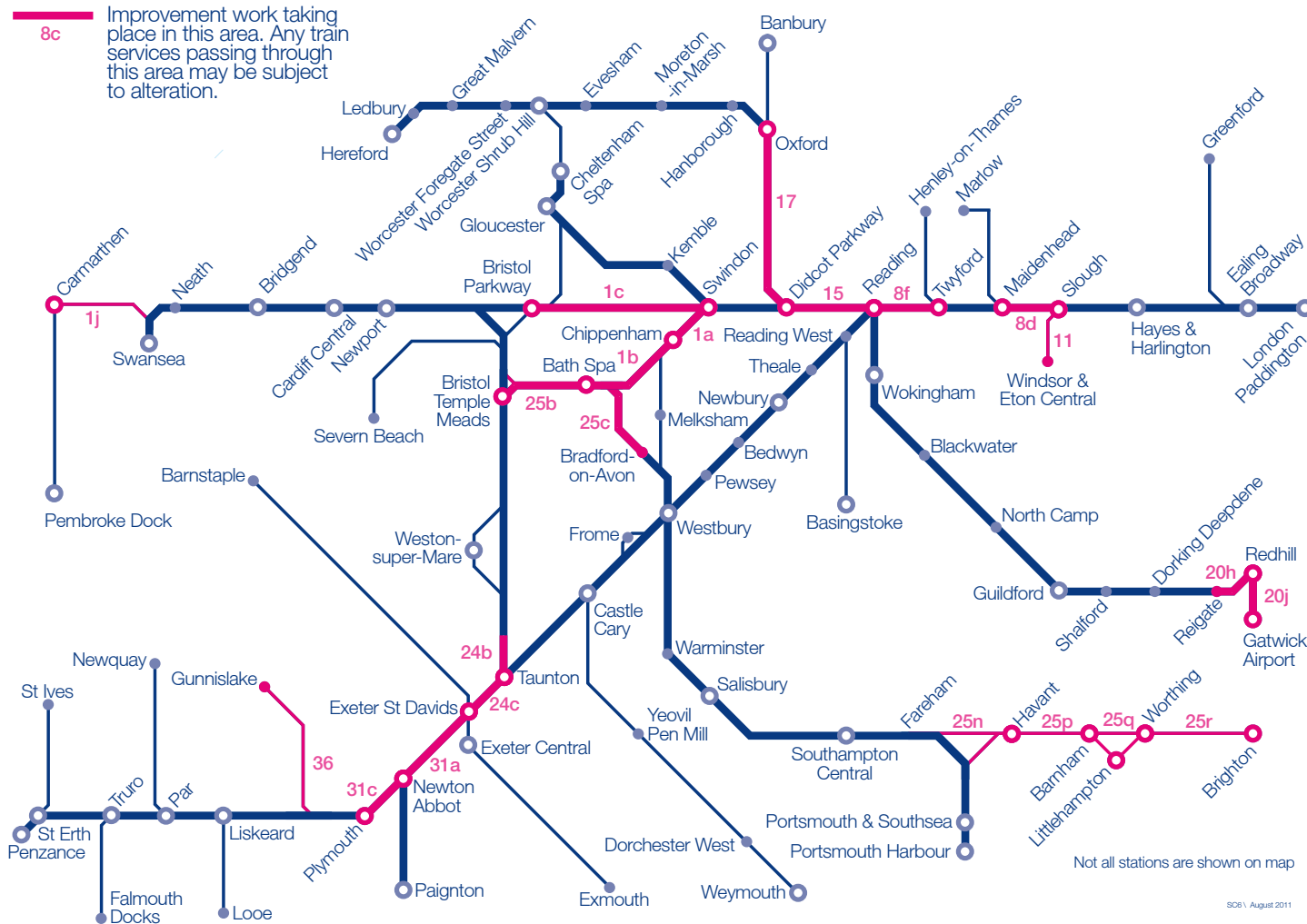


Summary of timetable changes

AREA	DETAILS
1a, 1b	Saturday - The 2235 and 2330 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads services will not call Chippenham or Bath Spa. Replacement buses will be in operation.
1a, 1b	Until approximately 1135 Sunday services between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads / Weston-super-Mare will be subject to alteration between Swindon and Bristol Temple Meads. Some trains will be diverted, retimed or replaced with buses for part of the journey.
1a, 1b	From approximately 2125 Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday until 0200 the following morning services between Swindon and Bristol Temple Meads will be retimed.
1c	Sunday - The 2237 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads service will be diverted and will call at Bristol Temple Meads before being extended to Bristol Parkway.
1j	Saturday and Sunday - First Great Western services will not run between Swansea and Carmarthen. Alternative Arriva Trains Wales train / bus services will be operating between Swansea and Carmarthen.
8d	Saturday - Until approximately 0515 trains will be unable to call at Taplow and Burnham. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow connecting with train services.
8f	Monday to Friday - The 2315 Reading to London Paddington service will be retimed to depart Reading at 2322.
8f	Tuesday to Friday - The 0015 Reading to London Paddington service will be retimed to depart Reading at 0028.
11	From approximately 2115 Sunday until 0200 the next day buses will be replacing trains between Slough and Windsor & Eton Central.
15	Monday - The 0412 Didcot Parkway (starting from Oxford) to London Paddington service will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
17	From 2300 Sunday evening until 0500 the following morning trains will be extended to run between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. The replacement buses shown in the published timetables will not run.
20h, 20j	Sunday - Reading to Gatwick Airport train services will start / terminate at Reigate. Replacement buses will run between Reigate and Gatwick Airport and between Reigate and Redhill.
20j	Saturday - The 2334 Reading to Gatwick Airport service will terminate at Redhill. An alternative train service will run from Redhill to Gatwick Airport.
24b, 24c	Sunday - Some services between Bristol Temple Meads and Exeter St Davids will be retimed or revised due to improvement work in the Taunton area and in the Exeter area.
25b, 25c	Until approximately 1300 Sunday - some services between Bristol Parkway and Westbury will be retimed due to improvement work near Bath Spa. Some services will be departing earlier than normal train times.
25n - 25r	Saturday and Sunday - Most First Great Western services which normally run to / from Brighton will be diverted to start / terminate at Portsmouth Harbour. Alternative Southern services will run Fareham to Chichester and Littlehampton and Brighton. Buses will run between Chichester and Littlehampton.
31a, 31c	Sunday - The line between Exeter St Davids and Plymouth will be closed and services on these routes will be subject to alteration with buses replacing trains.
31a	Tuesday to Friday - The 0534 Exeter St Davids to Paignton service will be retimed to depart earlier at 0447 and will run earlier as far as Newton Abbot.
36	Sunday - Some services on the Plymouth to Gunnislake route will be retimed to maintain connections at Plymouth. This is due to a revised timetable in operation on the main line.
