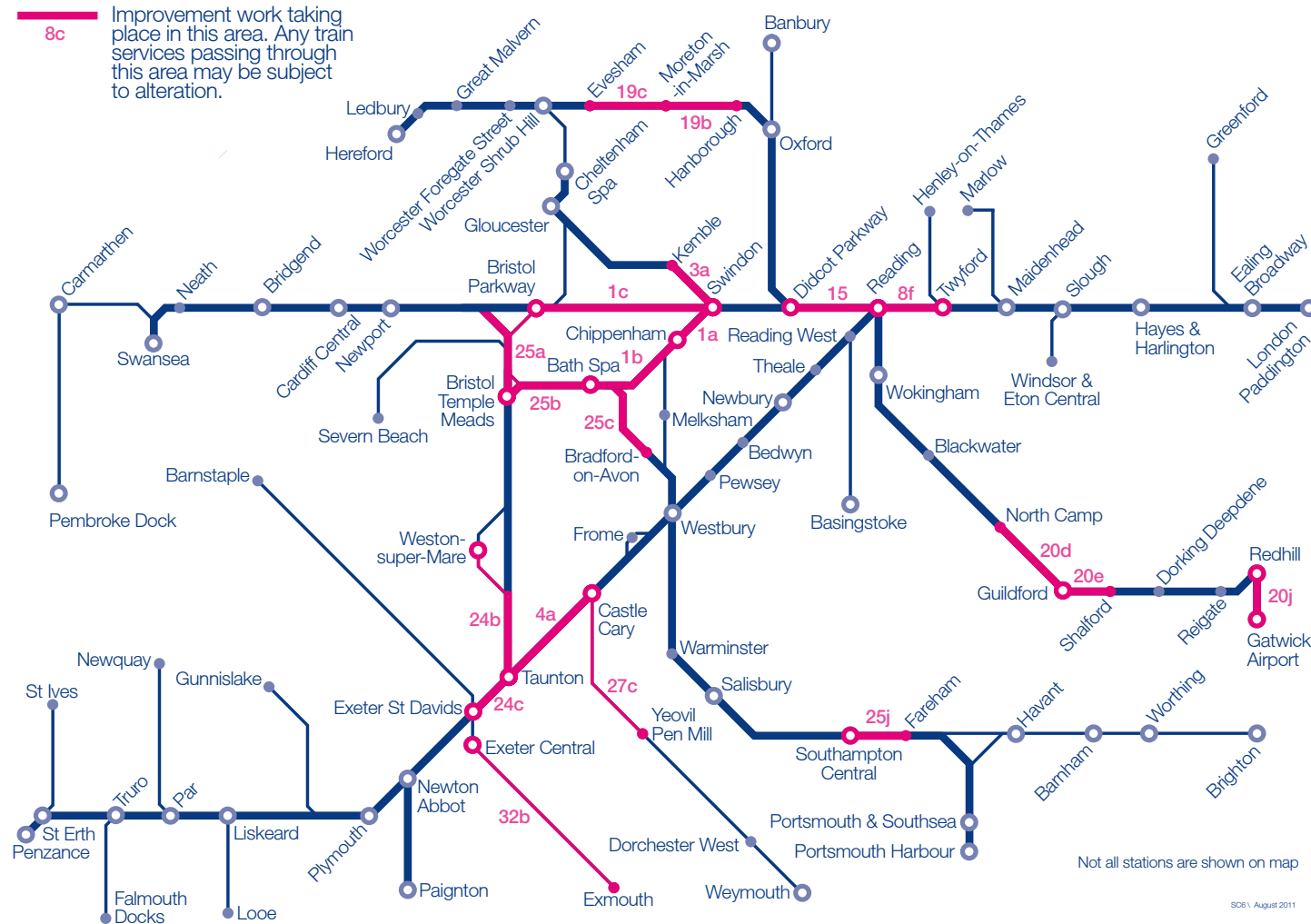


# Summary of timetable changes

AREA	DETAILS
1a, 1b, 25b	From 2000 Saturday and all day Sunday services between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads and beyond will be diverted and will not call Chippenham or Bath Spa. Replacement buses will be in operation. Customers are advised to check journey times before travelling.
1c	Monday to Friday - The 2245 London Paddington to Swansea service will be diverted and will arrive later than normal train times beyond Swindon.
3a	Saturday - The 1900 Cheltenham Spa to London Paddington service will terminate at Swindon. Alternative train services will run between Swindon and London Paddington.
3a	Sunday - The 2005 Cheltenham Spa to London Paddington service will terminate at Swindon. Alternative train services will run between Swindon and London Paddington.
4a	Until approximately 1600 Sunday - A revised timetable will be in operation between London Paddington and Exeter St Davids, Plymouth and Penzance with trains being retimed, diverted or not running. Some will also be replaced with buses for part of the journey.
8f	Saturday - Most services which run between Reading and London Paddington will be retimed by a few minutes with some services running earlier than normal train times. Also services between London Paddington and Bedwyn will only run between Reading and Bedwyn. Customers travelling between London Paddington and Reading should use alternative train services.
8f	Sunday - Due to improvement work in the Reading area some local services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will be retimed by a few minutes.
15	Monday - The 0412 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington service will not call at Pangbourne. A bus will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst to connect with the train.
15	From approximately 2130 Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday until 0500 the following morning trains will be unable to call at Pangbourne. Buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst connecting with train services.
19b, 19c	Sunday - Services between London Paddington and Worcester, Great Malvern and Hereford will be subject to alteration with buses replacing trains between Charlbury and Evesham.
20d, 20e	Sunday - Until approximately 1600 services between Reading and Gatwick Airport will be running to a revised timetable with buses replacing trains between North Camp and Shalford.
20j	Monday to Thursday - The 2334 Reading to Gatwick Airport service will terminate at Redhill. An alternative train will run from Redhill to Gatwick Airport.
24b	Saturday - The 2030 London Paddington to Exeter St Davids and 2159 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will terminate at Weston-super-Mare. Buses will run from Weston-super-Mare to Exeter St Davids.
24b	Sunday - Until approximately 1415 services between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton will be operating to a revised timetable with some services being replaced with buses for part of the journey.
24c	From approximately 2200 Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday until 0200 the following morning services between Taunton and Tiverton Parkway will be retimed by a few minutes.

AREA	DETAILS
25a	<b>Monday to Wednesday</b> - The 2327 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads service will be retimed to run a few minutes later than normal train times beyond Patchway.
25b, 25c	<b>From 2000 Saturday and all day Sunday</b> the line will be closed between Bristol Temple Meads and Bath Spa. As a result services between Cardiff Central, Bristol Temple Meads and Westbury, Weymouth, Portsmouth and Brighton will be operating to a revised timetable with trains diverted to alternative stations and buses replacing trains for part of the journey.
25j	<b>From approximately 2200 Saturday and all day Sunday</b> services will be diverted via an alternative route between Southampton Central and Fareham. Some services will be retimed to run earlier than normal train times.
27c	<b>Saturday</b> - Buses will be replacing trains between Castle Cary and Yeovil Pen Mill. Customers travelling between Weymouth and Westbury and beyond are advised to check journey times before travelling.
27c	<b>Monday to Thursday</b> - The 2049 Bristol Temple Meads to Weymouth service will be replaced with a bus service between Castle Cary and Yeovil Pen Mill.
32b	<b>Sunday</b> - Train services to / from Exmouth will not run between Exeter Central and Exmouth. Replacement buses will run between Exeter St Davids, Exeter Central and Exmouth.
